Romans 8 lists 7 aspects of Hope

- 1. 8:1 In Christ our condemnation is gone
- 2. 8:17,18 As heir's in Christ, we have an inheritance
- 3. 8:28 God will work everything out for our good, if we are in Christ
- 4. 8:31 If God is for us, who could be against us

- 5. 8:33 no one can bring a charge against us
- 6. 8:34 Jesus is interceding for us
- 7. 8:35-39 nothing can separate us from His love

Seven statements we need to hold on to

- 1. God is in control
- 2. What we see now is not the whole story, eternity awaits
- 3. God loves us in the middle of life's trials
- 4. Real hope is ours thru Christ
- 5. No matter what we face, we are never separated from Christ's love
- 6. We do overcome thru Christ
- 7. Our task is to bring this message to a hopeless world
